

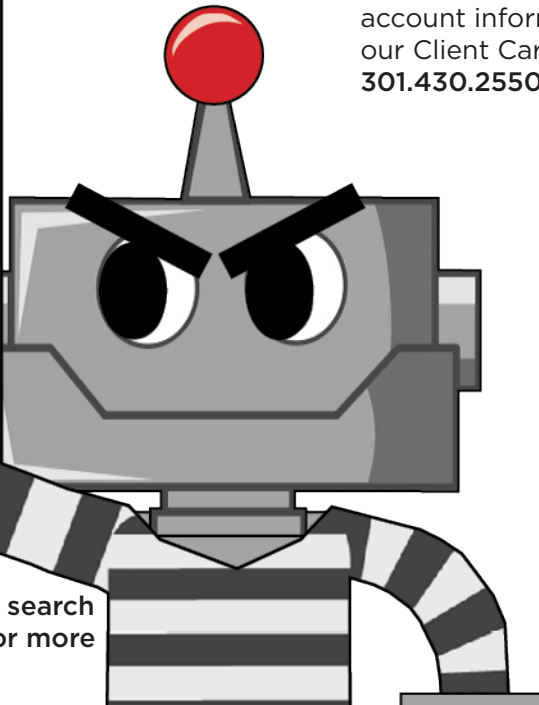
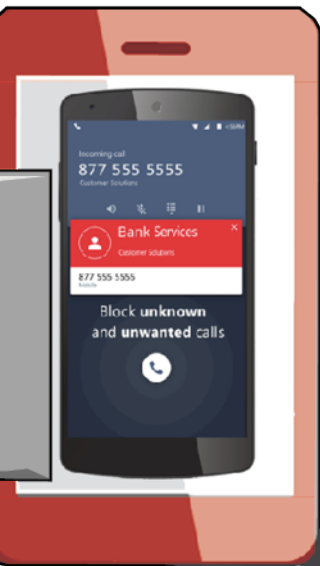

# NEW SCAM ALERT: Phone Number Spoofing

Con artists and robocallers are now using technology to modify what phone number appears on caller ID. This is used to impersonate neighbors, friends, local businesses and authorities.

If you get a call from someone claiming to be Old Line Bank, follow these tips:

- **Avoid answering calls from unknown numbers.**
- **Never give the caller your information,** such as financial or personal.
- **Write down the details,** such as the number and name of the caller.
- **Hang up.**
